

MISSOURI REPEATER COUNCIL, Inc.
ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES

July 31, 2021

Call to Order:

President James Adkins, KB0NHX, called the meeting to order on July 31 at 11:05 via Zoom video conference. It was determined a quorum was present with a total of 26 attending.

Introduction of Officers:

The officers and board members introduced themselves. The Secretary took member attendance when they joined the Zoom call.

Minutes of the 2020 Annual Meeting Approval:

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the 2020 MRC Annual meeting. The motion passed.

Treasurer's Report:

Old Business:

Repeater Coordination Update

James Adkins gave an update of the database scrub activities. The coordinators have been contacting the contacts/trustees of all repeaters that have not been updated in 2019 and before. They have been successful in resolving all but 42 repeaters out of 166. In the process, 53 repeaters have been de-coordinated, and those 2 Meter and 70 Centimeter frequency pairs have been reclaimed for re-coordination. A list of the outstanding repeaters was displayed, and the membership present was asked to help resolve the remainder. This list is attached to the minutes.

James also reviewed the current list of repeaters “Under Construction” or “Down Temporarily”. Of those under construction, the majority of those are long past the construction deadline. The coordinators are reaching out to those repeater contacts/trustee. If no contact is made, the coordination may be revoked to allow reassignment of the frequency pair. There are 13 repeaters that are from 181 to 708 days past the construction deadline.

There are five (5) repeaters that are currently listed as “Down Temporarily”. A copy of the “Under Construction and Down Temporarily” list is attached to these minutes,

Website and Database Update

James Adkins gave the following updates on the website and database.

1. A SSL certificate was added to the website so you can now use <https://missourirepeater.org> and the lock icon is present.
2. Added a FAQ page on the website. The FAQ page provides a plethora of information on how to properly fill out your application for coordination.
3. The MRC email server was updated to better facilitate mass emails to the membership.
4. A “Forgot My Password” option was added to the database logon page to readily reset their password.
5. The Coordination Tools were completed. This tool allows the coordinators to quickly find an open frequency and check for compliance issues with open frequencies for a given location in the state as well as responding to requests from adjacent states.

State Frequency Coordinator

President James Adkins has appointed Bryon Jeffers, K0BSJ, as State Frequency Coordinator. Bryon has done this job before, so his appointment brings previous coordinator experience.

Bryon’s appointment was confirmed by a vote of the membership attending.

New Business:

Change in the Coordination Guidelines

A proposal was placed before the membership for the “Revocation and Termination of Coordinated Frequencies” section of the Coordination Guidelines.

This change will require repeater trustees or contacts to log into the Missouri Repeater Council database annual to either “Verify Repeater Data” or make appropriate changes to their repeater(s). After two (2) years of no activity, coordinators will begin the de-coordination process and after three (3) years of no contact with the repeater trustee or contact, the repeater will be de-coordinated.

This proposed change was approved by a vote of the membership present. There was no other new business.

Election of Officers:

President: James Adkins, KB0NHX, filled out the remainder of Cecil Higgins’ term which expired in 2021. James has agreed to stand for election of President. The floor was opened for any other nominations for President. No one else was nominated, so the nominations were closed, and James was elected by acclamation.

Directors at Large: The term for Jeff Young, KB3HF, expires in 2021. Jeff agreed to stand for re-election. James Adkins previous position as Director at Large is open due to his appointment to fill out the previous president’s term. The floor was opened for nominations to Director At Large. Bob Brown, W0NQX, was nominated. No other nominations were made, and nominations were closed. Both Jeff and Bob were elected by a vote of the membership present to the position of Director at Large.

Meeting Date for 2022 Annual Meeting:

The board will set the date for the next meeting to the last Saturday in July or first Saturday in August. The meeting date will be announced on the website.

Motion to Adjourn:

A motion was made, seconded to adjourn. The motion carried.
