Items to be brought before the membership include elections for four positions; President, Vice-President and two Director at Large positions. The President will be putting together a presentation for the annual meeting to highlight how and what the council does. Changes to the Bi-Laws will be presented to be voted on by the membership concerning dues and voting.

The State Frequency Coordinator reported that there were no available UHF/VHF frequency pairs available in the Kansas City area. There was also discussion about the de-coordination of frequency pairs that the council has not been able to verify that are on the air. It was decided to publish a list of the proposed frequencies to de-coordinate on the web site and at the annual meeting. If confirmation of the frequencies has not been obtained by October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025, they will be de-coordinated.

There was discussion about suspending dues and creating a reserve/emergency fund.

It was decided to move forward with gaining access to the back files for the data base and web site so the Officers could have access in the event of something going wrong more than one person had access.

It was also decided that the Council be more public about helping other amateur radio operators with repeater issues if asked.
